I write on behalf of West Australian Assistance Dogs - a not for profit organisation providing assistance dogs and companion dogs for people in Western Australia. Staffed entirely by volunteers, with all of our funds generated through memberships, donations and our own merchandise we train and provide these dogs free of charge. We only service clients in Western Australia and money we raise stays in this state.

Currently there are 12 dogs in our program at various stages of training with more puppies due to arrive in the next 6 months; consequently, the need for puppy raisers and puppy sitters is quite critical. For this reason I am enquiring as to whether you could notify your membership base either in your newsletter or on your training days as to our current search for volunteers who may be able to assist us.

Generally we prefer no more than one dog at the premises that our pup will be housed at, however ownership of more than one dog does not automatically disqualify a potential candidate. All candidates are thoroughly screened before placement of one of our pups occurs and providing detailed information on our application along with home visits by our trainers to determine suitability of premises is a prerequisite.

Should your club hold fund raising days we would appreciate you considering our organisation as a beneficiary and we could attend any fundraising day held on our behalf to conduct a demonstration. Your members could then meet with some of our clever canines and their trainers.
